

CCP- What Next?

Steps to Participating in CCP

- Attend CCP meeting
- Turned in **Intent to Participate & EHS Counseling form.**
 - o These must be turned in no later than April 1, 2018!
- Go to College website (i.e., utoledo.edu, owenscc.edu), go to CCP page and **APPLY!**
- Bring **Consent & Approval Form** to Mrs. Roper **–OR–** Get the Consent & Approval form from Mrs. Roper **if going to UT.**
- Take College entrance **exam/assessment** (i.e., ACT, SAT or Accuplacer)
 - o You must contact and schedule a time with the University to take the Accuplacer.
 - o Accuplacer scores will go directly to that College
 - o If you are able, please bring a copy of your scores to Mrs. Roper
 - o PSAT scores, currently do not count as one of these assessments
- Once all of these things are done the college will review this. When they have made their decision they will send you an email confirming this decision and what to do from there next.
 - o You will schedule your college classes with them.
 - o Email or bring Mrs. Roper a copy of your class schedule
 - Meet with Mrs. Roper to adjust your EHS schedule and to confirm course meets graduation requirements.
 - Each semester you will need to email/bring Mrs. Roper your CCP schedule and adjust your EHS schedule.
 - o Each Quarter/college Midterm you will need to turn in your current CCP class grade for grade cards and eligibility purposes.
 - o You will also need to turn in your CCP grades at the end of each semester.
- Books: bring a copy of your book receipt with your name on it to the Counseling office and turn in to Mrs. Roper. You must do this each term.
 - o Books have to be borrowed from the school, rented from the college, bought from the college. ***They cannot be purchased & reimbursed for on your own.***

University of Toledo

 - April 1 Summer
 - May 1 Fall
 - Nov. 1 Spring
- Take placement test
- Get Consent & Approval to Mrs. Roper
- School will send transcript & Consent & Approval to UT
- **Requirements:** 2.5 GPA or higher, SAT/ACT/Accuplacer min. scores, Consent & Approval form, official Transcript

Owens Community College

- 1. Applicants must submit the following documents to Owens:

 2. [CCP Authorization Form Academic Year 2018-2019](#)
 3. [Parent Signature Form](#)
 4. Official high school transcripts
- 2. Applicants are highly encouraged to take the Owens [placement test](#). Students must place into most college-level classes on the reading, math and writing assessment for most classes. Applicants may waive the placement test if they have achieved the following or better on the ACT: Reading (22) and English (18) or Math (22).
- 3. Log into your [Ozone account](#) with your new credentials after applying. Once logged in, feel free to explore your Ozone account. If you are having trouble getting into your account, please call Help Desk at (567) 661.7120. Make sure to have your social security on you for confirmation when you call.
- 4. Students are subject to the academic probationary measures by Owens if the student fails to achieve an adequate GPA.
- 5. **The registration deadline for College Credit Plus students are:**
 - a. For Spring Semester 2018: January 5, 2018
 - b. For Summer Semester 2018: May 11, 2018
 - c. For Fall Semester 2018: August 24, 2018
 - d. For Spring Semester 2019: January 18, 2019
- 6. Applicants agree to abide by all the policies and procedures of Owens as well as any specific to this program. Students and their parents or guardian are required to participate in a mandatory CCP college orientation program.

Northwest State Community College

- Complete a CCP Application for Admission online at NorthwestState.edu/apply-now
- Submit a signed **CCP Consent Form to your high school counselor**. Your application is not complete until we receive your CCP Consent Form.
 - Deadline: Summer Term: March 1
 - Fall Term: April 15
 - Spring Term: November 1
- Turn in **Consent form** in:
 - June 15 deadline for Fall term
 - November 15 for Spring Term
- Complete the **ACCUPLACER Assessment or submit your ACT Scores**. You must meet the state qualifying score in at least one area to be eligible for the CCP Program. Minimum qualifying scores are:
- Take Accuplacer by the following deadlines:
 - Summer Term: May 1 // Fall Term: June 30 // Spring Term: December 1
- Follow the rest of Northwest State's Acceptance procedures
