- Criteria: Opened to enrolled high school seniors in Fulton County, OH school system. Applicant must have volunteered with an organization. Grade point average between 2.5 and 4.0. Must be accepted and planning to attend a two or four year degree program.

- Award: at least 4 \$500 awards

- Award: Varies
- Criteria: Incoming freshmen being admitted to OSU, preferably top 10% in his/her high school class, must be recommended by principals, teachers, and counselor.

Workforce Demand Scholarship-Terra State Community College

- Award: Scholarship will pay the gap between the cost of tuition and general fees and all state and federal grants received by the student.
