- Deadline: November 3, 2017.

- Criteria: One entry per student, must be original work, any subject
- Award: \$25-\$500
- Apply: See counseling office or EHS English teachers for application
- Deadline: Must be mailed in by November 8, 2017.

- Award:(2 per county) Presidential(Full tuition), (50) Honors(Half Tuition)
- Apply: Go to website above (Visit NSCC Sat, Nov. 4, 2017 9:30-12:30)
- Deadline: Apply by April 1, 2017

Advance Scholarship Program

- Criteria: Scholarship is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students. Must submit an essay on given topics related to travel.
- Award: \$500

- Deadline: October 10, 2017

DAR Good Citizens Scholarship

- Criteria: Must be a senior who is a dependable person, a leader, a patriotic student, and a person who makes acts of service.
- Award: Once eligible to enter, the student has a chance to earn \$500 at the state level and \$5,000 at the national level.
- Apply: Must be chosen out of the school to be the school's DAR Good Citizen, then has the opportunity to enter the DAR Good Citizens scholarship contest (see Guidance Office)
- Deadline: October 22, 2017

Vivint Smart Home Scholarship

- Criteria: Must be high school senior or college student Must be planning on or already enrolled in one of the eligible majors
- Award: \$1,000
- Apply: Submit an application and post a 1-2 minute video creatively responding to a prompt. <https://www.vivint.com/scholarships#application>
- Deadline: October 1, 2017

Prudential Spirit of Community Award

- Criteria: Any student grades 5-12 who have participated in community service that occurred at least in part after September 1, 2016
- Award: \$1,000 or more
- Apply: Apply at spirit.prudential.com or see G.O.
- Deadline: November 7, 2017

Danforth Scholarship

- Criteria: Students that are leaders in service and demonstrate academic excellence applying to Washington University in St. Louis
- Award: Full or partial tuition scholarships renewed each year
- Apply: See Mrs. Roper for nomination
- Deadline: Must be nominated by November 15, 2017

Horatio Alger Scholarship

- Criteria: High school graduation in spring summer, commit to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree, demonstrated critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross income), and minimum GPA of 2.0
- Award: Ranges from \$6,000 to \$25,000
- Apply: Apply at scholars.horatioalger.org and see Mrs. Roper
- Deadline: October 25, 2017

Wendy's Heisman Scholarship

- Criteria: High school senior with minimum 3.0 GPA, proven leader and role model within school and community, and must perform in at least one school sponsored sport.
- Award: Ranges from \$1,000 to \$10,000
- Apply: Apply at wendysheisman.com
- Deadline: Complete and submit Phase 2 of your application by October 23, 2017 at 3 p.m.
